Though the grades children will be moving off-site, all of our Early Childhood classes will continue to meet at our Magnolia Campus. Our EC teachers are preparing their curriculum to include extended time outdoors.

We will be sharing more details about off-site locations soon and will be looking for volunteers to help build platforms and move desks and materials soon.
